“My Summarized Ministry Trip to UK—June 24 through July 3, 2008”

What a trip we had to the UK. My two assistant and myself just arrived home yesterday on July 3rd with lots of fruit for our work for the Lord in UK! The following paragraphs summarize our trip to UK:

Donna Castellow from Virginia, and me, Emily, from King, NC, both met Denise May, who flew from NY., to meet us in the airport, in Charlotte, NC. We three flew out together to UK, June 24th, at 8:30 p.m. We arrived at the UK airport Wednesday, June 25th at 9:30 a.m. without a wink of sleep all night.

As I waited on Donna to get her purse she had left on the plane, I prayed for a Hindu man in luggage dept. His back was healed and He asked Jesus into his heart, and Donna prayed for a girl in customs.

God did more than I imagined. I was gone ten days so I am flooded with emails to answer, but I want everyone to know we are home and happy that God did save, and filled people with His Holy Spirit, and healed so many people. We are still rejoicing that God had encouraged and uplifted so many.

Thursday June 26: As my 1st service ended a Moslem Lebanese lady hugged and told me she enjoyed my teaching. Then I led her to the Lord and gave her my CD. We must pray daily for this new convert to stay true to Jesus, when pressures try to make her faith in the Lord waver or turn back.

Friday & Saturday: I taught on faith; I told many of my ministry experiences, how God answers prayers; we confessed faith confessions aloud, all-together and they were encouraged and rejoiced.

Sunday a.m. June 29: Church filled up with God's Glory. I never got to minister the word, as people ran to the altar for prayer; we prayed for the entire church Sunday a.m. Several got the Holy Ghost and many were healed; they were so happy no one hurried to leave church; they stayed to 2:00 p.m.

Sunday p.m. After I had taught the p.m. service, Donna, Denise, and I, prayed for all the Church. I prayed delivered on a woman victimized by demon spirits; after service ended that night she and her husband kept hugging me. Deliverance brings great rewards. God gives us joy and He also gives the one set free enough joy to transform their faces after the deliverance is completed.

After service, many were sad knowing we soon will depart; some visited our motel room; we spent lots of time in fellowship. It was my last church service, yet we stayed 4 more days. Pastor Bayo's building did not seat all the people, so Rev. Edwards had let us use his Church and we were so grateful. He and his wife were sweet and I really enjoyed meeting them as I felt their kindred spirit. I also, felt Pastor Bayo, and his wife, Agatha's, kindred spirit, as well. They all were so kind.

Pastor Bayo had suggested months ago that we may want to stay over to tour London. Never did I dream they would treat us so nice and shower us with such love, or give us so many gifts

and put us in the nicest hotel there. They paid for my tours as well as my two assistants and my friend, Lisbeth, from Finland, as well. No one has shown me more love than these Christian brothers and sisters.

Monday 11 to 12 noon: A powerful Christian Radio station in London interviewed me. I had favor with the lady interviewer who had read my book; she had advertised it on Radio. Back home, I had book-orders to fill from my UK Radio interview. One lady said the station plays bits of my interview daily.

Though Church services ended p.m., June 29; we toured London until leaving for home on July 3rd.

Monday p.m. After my Radio interview had ended, we all toured London until darkness began to fall.

We returned to our motel and ate food in the room with some ladies from the church. It was like a big joyful party each night in the motel room. There was no time for homesickness, or to be lonely at all.

Tuesday: We toured London again all day and saw many famous places downtown London. We had pictures made with a pretty bride; we the have photos to show. Fellowship and fun truly was great. Donna and Denise kept everyone laughing. They helped make the trip be so much fun. They were a blessing to me and to the people there, in UK. We all together were a happy bunch of campers.

Tuesday p.m. We had dinner at Pastor Bayo's house; what a dinner spread they had! Some church ladies were there. They gave some gifts after dinner and took pictures also. Then, I prayed for Pastor Bayo's two sons; the largest one got the Holy Ghost. Then, I prayed for Tracey's deaf ear. I knew it would be opened, because that is one of my gifts from God, she was very happily surprised. Then, we had laughter and fun as Donna and Denise modeled their outfits a lady had given to them.

Wednesday: We saw Buckingham Palace and changing of Guards. Weather was beautiful all the time while there; the Church had prayed for nice weather. They also had us staying in a beautiful motel where elaborate weddings are daily events. We won people to Jesus where-ever we had listening ears. I prayed for one in a sandwich-shop, after her back was healed she took Jesus into her heart, and we led a motel waitresses to Jesus. Denise got a motel gardener saved. God touched a motel-employee that Donna & Denise brought to me. She got the Holy Ghost as I prayed for her. She was sad coming in and rejoiced going out. I told two Moslem men about Jesus; they said they believed in Him too.

Lisbeth, in Finland flew to UK to tour with us; she had found me on my website. Church paid our tour fees, and meals, even when touring. Donna, our guide, is David's wife, helped us pick out material for a new outfit. Then she took us to her Tailor, who quickly made our Indian style outfits. In March, I was invited to minister in India; now we have new Indian style outfits so we will pray about going there.

We had a farewell party Wednesday, our last night there. We modeled our new outfits at an exclusive restaurant, in a room they had reserved for us. With hugs, kisses, tears of joy and tears of sadness also, we left them, knowing we would miss their smiling faces as they love us, and our love for them was mutual. They asked us to return and bring Dr. Norvel Hayes with us next time.

We cannot forget the van driver who patiently drove us around, and listened to our chatter. I think he may have enjoyed the laughter and our prayers that even shook the van, as we prayed daily. Also, David who is so talented and who made pretty flyers for my website to advertise my meeting, has volunteered to rework all my CD & DVD album-inserts to make them professional looking. I praise God for both David and Donna, his wife, for all their kindness and generosity of those sweet people.

We will never forget our spiritual brothers or sisters, or Lisbeth, from Finland. We miss their smiling faces and fellowship. Lisbeth said she may visit me in NC sometime. Sunday a.m. service isn't taped because the Holy Ghost swept in, and so, only 4 CDs are available for sale, from my UK meeting.

I'm at home now with jet-lag, tired, but happy! I need a few days rest. It's best to write about my ministry trip, and let my voice rest, as I used it so much it is worn a bit. I thank Rev. Bayo and wife, Agatha for inviting us to UK, and I thank them for their gifts and love. I am thankful for everyone's prayers at home, while we were in UK.
